

Facilities

We have outstanding facilities – enabling our students to benefit from a large range of extra-curricular activities and opportunities.

Pastoral Care

Community, belonging and a deep-seated sense of friendship play a major role in pupils' time at Worksop College and Ranby House Prep School.

Our on-site Healthcare centre is run by qualified nurses, who have, between them, a large and varied amount of nursing experience.

Our Wellbeing Hub is a bespoke health and happiness classroom, taught using screen-less, collaborative and consent based techniques. This classroom provides a unique space for students to learn knowledge, practice tools and self reflect.

Transport

Families have the option to book Worksop College buses for transfers to/from the airport.

Academic Profile

We offer outstanding academic opportunities, and our small class sizes result in happy, successful students who make excellent progress. We provide an extensive academic enrichment programme, with visiting university lecturers offering aspirational advice, as well as strong links with local and regional business.

In 2019, our A level cohort achieved a 100% pass rate and joined some of the best universities and organisations in the world. In 2017, over 50% of our students bound for university went to Russell Group universities, including six to Oxbridge.

In February 2016, a brand new 60-bed boys' boarding house was opened, accommodating the growing, thriving boarding community. Weekly, Flexi and casual boarding is provided at both the Preparatory School and The Senior School for boys and girls.

Our overseas students are integrated quickly into our community, moving into one of eight well-equipped and comfortable Houses

Until the Sixth Form, pupils tend to share a spacious rooms with two or three other pupils. In the Lower Sixth, it is usual to share with one other student and in the Upper Sixth, most students have single study bedrooms. Each House has a live-in Housemistress or Housemaster who oversee the running of the House, to make it a truly home-from-home environment.

Meals are taken in the Great Hall, and food is outstanding. Boarders also have modern kitchen facilities in their accommodation, which are regularly stocked with drinks and snacks.

Teaching and Learning

We offer a wide range of subjects and have an excellent EAL provision, as well as full support for overseas students when getting used to life in a British Boarding school. Pupils from overseas have two scheduled sessions of EAL per week as part of their timetable. There are also EAL specialists available for those who might need more support.

GCSE

With Prep (or homework) time included as part of the school day – pupils have access to a host of specialist teachers, on-hand to help when help is needed, as well as access to our well-resourced and well-regarded Learning Support Team.

All departments offer subject 'clinics' outside the school day, with the core subjects offering five clinic sessions every single week. At GCSE, our curriculum is designed to be flexible, offering amazing choice across a wide range of subjects, as well as extra-curricular opportunities that will help build independence, resilience and adaptability.

A level and BTEC

Although most of the subjects we offer are at A level, we have a small, but growing number of vocational qualifications. Currently offered across Food & Nutrition, Science, Business and Sport, we have plans to introduce a broader vocational curriculum as demand grows, from both students themselves, and the industries they will eventually join.
