Accommodation during Welcome Weekend

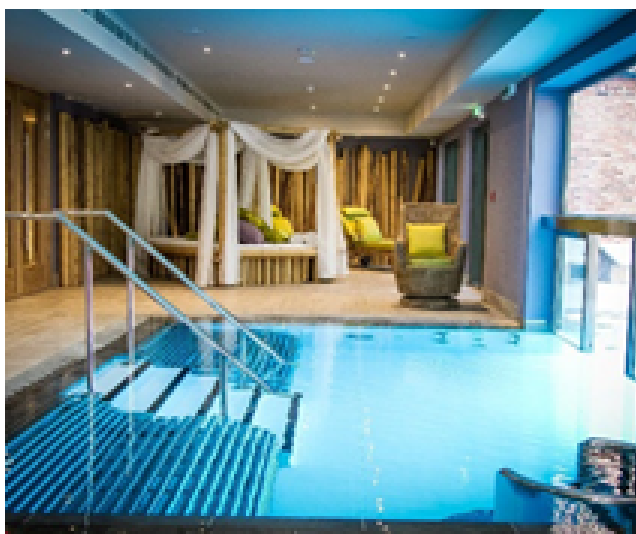

Sunday 5 September - 'Family Day'

You will be picked up from your hotel at 8.45am and taken to Worksop College which is located approximately 15 minutes' drive away. This day is an opportunity for you to meet teachers and House staff, as well as learn more about the school and what means to be the parent of a boarder. The day will conclude with a formal dinner, after which you will return to the hotel. Your son or daughter will check into a Boarding House.

9am	<p>Pick up from Ye Olde Bell – please be ready in the reception of the hotel at 8.45am, where you will be greeted by a member of Worksop College staff and driven to our school, approximately 20-minutes' drive away.</p> <p>Pupils should bring all their luggage; parents should bring what they require for the day – there will be an opportunity to return to the hotel to freshen up before dinner.</p>
9.30am	<p>Registration and refreshments at Worksop College</p> <p>Sign-in and meet the pupil who will guiding you for the day</p>
9.45am	<p>Welcome from the Head</p>
10am	<p>Your schedule for the day will include:</p> <p>Meet the Healthcare Team</p> <p>Meet our nurses and talk about any specific issues or queries you have</p> <p>Photo, passport and BRP registration</p> <p>Your child will have their photo taken and we will collect and process any documentation</p> <p>Pocket money administration</p> <p>If you want to leave your child with pocket money, we will collect this and keep it safe</p> <p>Tour of our school</p> <p>Your pupil guide will take you on a tour of our school and answer any questions</p> <p>Parenting a boarder</p> <p>A talk from one of our Senior Leaders</p> <p>Timetabling and choices (Yrs 10-13 only)</p> <p>Meet our Deputy Head (Academic) and finalise timetable. ONLY necessary if new pupils have NOT yet made subject choices.</p>
15.00	<p>Bus back to Ye Olde Bell Hotel</p> <p>An opportunity (parents only) to return to your hotel and freshen up, ready for the Welcome Dinner. Boarding pupils will be taken to their rooms to freshen up, ready for the Welcome Dinner.</p>
19.00	<p>International Welcome Dinner</p> <p>A chance to get to know teachers and fellow parents a little better over delicious meal</p> <p>Dress code: formal, but Black Tie not required</p>
22.00	<p>Return to hotel</p> <p>You will say your goodbyes and be returned to Ye Olde Bell Hotel via school minibus.</p>
