

Uniform Sizing Guide

<u>Chest Measurement Guide</u>

Most of our uniform items are based on chest size, so it is important that you measure your child prior to ordering uniform items from us.

To take your child's chest measurement, measure around the fullest part of their chest. For younger children, place the tape measure a few inches below their armpit and measure their chest there. For older children, particularly girls, the fullest part of their chest might be a little lower. Your child will be able to tell you what feels comfortable to them. Be sure not to pull the tape measure too tight as this can lead to buying shirts or blouses which are too small and strain at the buttons.

Girls Blouse

Our Girls Shirts are based on chest size, and are available in the following sizes:

White Blouse 26" to 44" – even sizes only

White Blouse with Blue Piped Collar 22" to 32" – even sizes only

Boys Shirt

Our Boy's Shirts are based on collar size, and are available in the below sizes. To measure your child's collar size, wrap the tape measure gently around the base of their neck. Put two fingers between the tape measure and their skin while you do this; this will ensure a more comfortable fit.

White Short Sleeve & Long Sleeve Shirts 12" to 18" - including half sizes

Gingham Short Sleeve & Long Sleeve Shirts 10.5" to 16" – including half sizes



Girls Kilt / Skirt

Senior skirts are sized by two measurements: waist size and length of skirt:

1. Waist

Measure your child's waist by finding the narrowest part of their torso; this is normally a couple of inches above their hip bone and often, but not always, in line with the bellybutton. If your child has no natural narrower part to their torso, take their waist measurement from about halfway between the bottom of their rib cage and the top of their hip bone. Pull the tape measure so it's snug but not tight against their waist and make sure they're not holding their breath! You don't need to add anything to the measurement for comfort as good quality school uniform will be designed with a little bit of 'ease' included.

Our skirts and kilts can be purchased in the following waist sizes: 18" to 40" including odd and even numbers.

2. Skirt Length

To take your child's skirt measurement, it's easier if they wear an existing school skirt or other skirt that they like the length of. Measure from their natural waist down to the hem of the skirt, ensuring the tape measure is in a straight line.

Our skirts and kilts can be purchased in the following lengths: 18" to 26" (even numbers only).

Please note, skirts and kilts need to come to the knee or longer.

Girls Pinafore / Summer Dress

Our Ranby House Pinafores and Summer Dresses are sized based on age. We understand that every child is different, so if your child is four years old, but usually fits a size three year dress, then please request a size three years when completing your order.



Boys Trousers

To take your child's trouser measurement, you will need two measurements:

1. Waist

Measure your child's waist by finding the narrowest part of their torso; this is normally a couple of inches above their hip bone and often, but not always, in line with the bellybutton. If your child has no natural narrower part to their torso, take their waist measurement from about halfway between the bottom of their rib cage and the top of their hip bone. Pull the tape measure so it's snug but not tight against their waist and make sure they're not holding their breath! You don't need to add anything to the measurement for comfort as good quality school uniform will be designed with a little bit of 'ease' included.

1. Inside Leg

This measurement will decide whether you require a short, regular or long length trouser. To take the inside leg measurement, ask your child to put on their school shoes and stand naturally. Run the tape measure down their inner leg, from their crotch to an inch or so above the ground where you'd like their trousers to finish. Try to ensure the tape measure is in a straight line, not wrapping around their leg, and don't pull it too tight or they'll end up with too-short, uncomfortable trousers.

Our trousers can be purchased in the following sizes:

Waist - 24" to 42" (even numbers only)

Length – Short, Regular and Long

Unisex Blazer

Our unisex blazers are based on chest size, and sizes range from 22" through to a 48" (even numbers only). If your child is in between sizes, we recommend purchasing the larger size blazer.

Please note - all of our blazers come with Smartsleeve®, meaning they can be adjusted down by 1.5inches for those students requiring a slightly longer arm length.



V-Neck Jumper

Our navy v-neck jumpers can be ordered in the following sizes:

Extra, Extra Small – 28/30" Extra Small – 31/32" Small – 32/34" Medium – 34/36" Large – 38/40" Extra Large – 42/44"

Sports Kit

All of our Ranby House Sports Kit (except those items listed below) is sized based on age. We understand that every child is different, so if your child is four years old, but usually fits a size three years, then please request a size three years when completing your order.

Worksop College Sports Kit is sized in XS, S, M, L and XL for unisex items. Some of our items do use female sizing (Sizes 8-18), so please advise a Unisex **and** a Female Size if ordering for a female student.

Adult tracksuit bottoms also come in three lengths – Short, Regular and Long.

Hockey / Rugby Socks

Small – UK Size 12-3 Medium – UK Size 3-7 Large – UK Size 7-11 Extra Large – UK Size 12-14

House Polo Shirt

House Polo Shirts depend on chest size and can be purchased in the following sizes:

Portland House (Boys) – 26" to 44" Mason House – 30" to 46" Pelham House – 30" to 44" Talbot House – 30" to 46" Shirley House – 30" to 44" Derry House - 30" to 40" Gibbs House - 30" to 40" School House - 30" to 40"



We also offer a ladies size 4, 6 and 8 in the Portland House Polo Shirt. House Socks

Portland Socks – Medium Size – UK Size 3-7 Other Houses - Large Size – UK 7-11

Sports Bag

There are two sizes of Sports Bag – Medium & Large. Medium Bags are suitable for RH Students, whilst Large Bags are suitable for WC Students.
